FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who receives the scholarships?

To qualify, current Covenant students must be from households with annual income of 200% or less of federal eligibility requirements to receive free or reduced lunch. These are families who otherwise could not afford a Covenant education.

How does the donation fund scholarships?

Your donation to The Covenant Fund at Sagamore funds need-based scholarships that have already been committed to qualified students for the current school year at Covenant Christian High School.

Is there a cap on tax credits available?

Yes. The state has allocated a certain amount per year in available tax credits, resetting annually on July 1. For July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2016, the tax credit cap is \$8.5 million. For July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017, the tax credit cap is \$9.5 million.

What happens if the tax credit cap has been reached for the year?

If the Department of Revenue informs us that the tax credit cap has been reached for the current state fiscal year, we will contact the donor and present the opportunity to delay the donation until the subsequent state fiscal year in which tax credits are available. If you donate during the fiscal year and receive your tax credit certification number, you can claim your credit even if the cap is reached later during that same fiscal year.

Can a donor carry over unused tax credits?

Yes, a donor can carryover unused tax credits for up to nine (9) subsequent years that the donor has state tax liability and has unused state tax credit available. Any unused tax credits cannot be refunded or carried back to previous years.

Can a donor make multiple donations to The Covenant Fund at Sagamore?

Yes. A donor can make as many donations as they would like and accumulate multiple tax credit certifications.
